## MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON 02-3-2017 AT 10-00 A.M. IN THE OFFICE OF CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, DISTRICT EDUCATION AUTHORITY, MULTAN TO REVIEW THE PROGRESS IN CONNECTION WITH SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS IN GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS OF DISTRICT MULTAN

A meeting was held on 02-3-2017 at 10-00 A..M, under the chair of Mr. Aezaz Ahmad Khan Joiya, Chief Executive Officer, District Education Authority, Multan in his office to review the progress in connection with Security Arrangements made in Public and Private schools of District Multan i.e. Activation of security Sims, School Guards, licenses and purchase of Weapons, CCTV, Metal Detectors and SOPs of security.

The meeting started with the recitation of Holy Quran. Mr. Aezaz Ahmad Khan Joiya, Chief Executive Officer, District Education Authority, Multan presided over and addressed the meeting. The chair described that the current scenario of security situation is very sensitive. In view of current security threats, the Government of the Punjab has directed to adopt all security measures to avoid any untoward incident in the future. The chair told that Mr. Nadir Chatta, Deputy Commissioner, Multan has also directed to ensure all possible security measures in all public and private schools of District Multan. Thereafter, Mr. Muhammad Javed Rafique, DEO(EE-M), Multan briefed regarding security arrangements made in the public and private schools of Elementary wing. Mr. Muhammad Riaz Khan, DEO(SE), Multan / Focal Person Security briefed regarding the security arrangements made in Higher and High schools of District Multan. He told that all necessary arrangements have been made in public and private schools of District Multan. Mrs. Fozia Hina, DEO(EE-W), Multan told that all necessary security arrangements have been made as per SOPs of security in the female Elementary and Primary schools of District Multan. Mr. Raza Ansari, Corporate Manager of U Phone Company briefed regarding the activation of U Phone Emergency sims that about three thousand Pre-Paid U phone sims were provided free of cost to the public and private schools of District Multan last year but about 2200 U phone sims have been blocked due to non up load of balance of Rs. 100/ per month by the users of Govt. Schools. The chair told that the Police authorities have requested / instructed for early activation of all blocked

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U Phone Sims due to serious emergency threat. Mr. Raza Ansari, Manager, U phone suggested that Post paid sims can be provided to all users of Govt. Schools on the deposit of Rs. 300/= per sim by the users. The minimum Rs. 110/- and maximum Rs.300/- per month bill will be charged per user. It was proposed by the DEOs that mobile set should be purchased out of NSB fund of the school and minimum payment of post paid bill may be made out of NSB fund of the school on monthly basis for proper activation / use of sims.

After discussion in detail, following decisions were taken to solve the different security issues in connection with ensuring security arrangements in public and private schools of District Multan.
