The meeting was commenced with the recitation from Holy Quran. The Chair reviewed the decisions made in the last DERC meeting. Dr. Atta DPC informed that matter regarding outstanding salary of staff was discussed in last CCMA meeting and Chair take a serious view and asked Secretary Health to take up the matter and it is hoped that approval would be granted. As regard to purchase of Android mobile sets, he informed that Lenovo A319 model of mobile sets are not available in open market while price of Android Samsung Mobile is out of range. However, Lenovo mobile phones will be arranged soon as discussed with retailer. The Chair asked to Dr. Atta for provision of required Android mobiles as early as possible and also pursue the summery of outstanding salary with the coordination of CEO Health Multan.

The Additional Deputy Commissioner (HQ) and Dr. Atta DPC informed that the issue regarding access of field teams in cantonment area for Anti-Dengue campaign has been resolved in the meeting of Base Commander and Maj. Humma. The representative of Multan Corporation informed that 4 zones have been earmarked and staff deputed for Anti-Dengue campaign as decided in last DERC meeting. PO PITB informed that one day training has been convened and desired to upload activity properly. The Chair directed to Dr. Atta DPC to ensure uploading of activity of corporation staff through Android Mobiles.

Dr. Atta DPC briefed about the activities of vector surveillance and IRS & Fogging from 02.01.2017 to 10.04.2017. Figures displayed are as under:-

It was informed that **113**-indoor and **14**-outdoor positive sites have been detected during vector surveillance in last 13 days. IRS & Fogging activities were also performed by the field teams in **32**-UCs during the period under discussion. Dr. Atta, DPC informed the Chair that notices have been issued to the owners of detected outdoor sites. PO PITB informed that unvisited hotspots have still reflected on the dashboard. Dr. Atta DPC explained that the figures of unvisited hotspot like mosques, graveyard etc. have wrongly been uploaded which may be corrected.

Afterwards, android-wise activities performed by all departments in Multan from 29.03.2017 to 10.04.2017 were also briefed. The figures, as reflecting on dashboard, are reproduced as under:-

The Chair directed to Dr. Atta to write a letter to Secretary Agriculture, Govt. of the Punjab, Lahore for non-cooperation of Agriculture Department in the Anti-Dengue Campaign.
